Business Supports-Type 1&2

Eligible Projects:

- Within 10km of the coastline, excluding metropolitan electoral districts
- Be an entrepreneurial initiative
- Be a micro or small enterprise
- Connection to the blue economy





Individual Training Supports- Type 3

- Individual completing the training must be the applicant, (not the employer or course provider)
- Accredited Training/Upskilling

Applicants must reside or work within 10km of the coastline

 Where the <u>training</u> facilitates entry to or <u>upskilling</u> within the blue economy
